The National Clinician Scholars Program (NCSP) is the only **postdoctoral research fellowship for physicians and doctorally-trained nurses across multiple disciplines and specialties**. Building on the legacy of the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation Clinical Scholars Program, the NCSP provides **advanced training in health services research and leadership** to tackle pressing healthcare challenges. Scholars explore diverse topics, from **artificial intelligence** and **climate change** to **health systems innovation** and **implementation science**, driving impact across clinical, public, and academic sectors.

With sites at top research universities, a competitive stipend, and access to prominent mentors, scholars engage in rigorous research and collaborate with faculty, multidisciplinary peers, and community partners. The program builds expertise in research design, leadership, and opportunities for community engagement while offering personalized mentorship and career planning. Our robust alumni network is shaping the future of health and health care.
